John A. Emrich has joined APJeT as the CEO and President. Mr. Emrich is the perfect compliment to APJeT's management team having spent over 35 years in the textile industry. His most recent position was that of CEO and President of Guilford Mills, Inc. located in Greensboro, NC.

Mr. Emrich served a Guilford's CEO from 2000-2005 and during that period was responsible for its restructuring in 2002 as well as redirecting its manufacturing focus to the automotive and industrial fabric business. This redirection changed Guilford from a 60% apparel manufacturer to an 85% value-added automotive supplier. APJeT founded in 2003 has developed an environmentally friendly and revolutionary "dry" textile treatment, using plasma technology, to impart a nano-coating to fabrics providing them with water repellent, stain repellent and wicking (moisture management) characteristics. APJeT is a privately held company which has received financing from Air Products and Chemicals and is the largest start-up to spin-off from Los Alamos National Labs.
